Peter Molloy is an international consultant and director with a strong pharmaceutical and biotech background.

He was Managing Director of Pharmacia Australia and then Vice President of Pharmacia's Strategic Marketing Group for Asia-Pacific & Latin America. Prior to being recruited to Pharmacia he was Division Manager for Faulding's Pharmaceuticals and General Manager of Selby Scientific & Medical. During his pharmaceutical career, Peter was directly responsible for the launch of more than 20 new pharmaceutical products into the Australian market, and at Pharmacia for the development and roll-out of many new products across 23 countries.

In 1998 he left the pharmaceutical industry and joined the biotech sector, where he served as CEO of three companies most recently including Biota Holdings Limited (2002-2005). Since 2005, he has been a consultant to life sciences companies in the US and Australia and is currently a director of Viralytics Limited (ASX:VLA) and President of the US operations of Synthesis Med Chem.

During his distinguished management career, he has raised more than \$75m in equity funds for small companies and executed substantial product and technology licensing deals with many companies, on both sides of the pharma-biotech table. Peter describes himself as a management professional whose consulting expertise extends to pipeline and deal valuations, strategic visioning and business planning, training and mentoring, and organisation culture evaluation and change.

He is a Fellow of the Australian Institute of Company Directors, has served on the boards of several companies including Chairman of two international companies. He holds a BSc in Biochemistry and Microbiology from the University of Melbourne, and an MBA from the University of Adelaide.
